## A. Review

And in thy name have cast out devils? And in thy name done many wonderful works? 23And then will I profess unto them, I never knew you: depart from me, ye that work iniquity.
  - 1 Corinthians 10:12 ("Let everyone who thinks that he stands, take heed lest he falls")
  - There are many Scriptures throughout the New Testament to let non-Christians know that they are not Christians and to give their lives to Jesus Christ.

- 1 John 3:4-10 (9No one who is born of God practices sin, because His seed abides in him; and he cannot sin, because he is born of God.)
