- 1. Finally (3063) = *as to the rest*, *in conclusion*, finally.
- 2. Be strong *(continuously)* [PIM-present imperative= be being strong] (1743); to be strengthened; to become strong.
 - In the Lord.
 - In the strength or KJV says power (2904) [kratos] = power that is a part of the nature of God. It is inherent power and ability.
 - Of His might (2479) [ischus] = the two words together means=the strength that has prevailed manifestly and demonstratively, translated "mighty power" and "power of His might."

 - Ephesians 6:11 (a)
 - > By putting on the full armor of God.
 - ✤ 2 Corinthians 7:1 (Therefore, having these promises, beloved, let us cleanse ourselves from all defilement of flesh and spirit, perfecting holiness in the fear of God.)

- Romans 13:11-14 (Therefore let us lay aside the deeds of darkness and put on the armor of light. ¹³ Let us behave properly as in the day, not in carousing and drunkenness, not in sexual promiscuity and sensuality, not in strife and jealousy. ¹⁴ But put on the Lord Jesus Christ, and make no provision for the flesh in regard to *its* lusts.)
- ✤ James 4:8 (⁸ Draw near to God and He will draw near to you. Cleanse your hands, you sinners; and purify your hearts, you double-minded.)
- Nehemiah 8:8-12 (¹⁰ Then he said to them, "Go, eat of the fat, drink of the sweet, and send portions to him who has nothing prepared; for this day is holy to our Lord. Do not be grieved, for the joy of the LORD is your strength.")
