### A. Review

- We gave everyone two assignments:
  - 1) Ask God for *the one thing* you wish that He would do for you in 2018.
  - 2) Ask God for *the one thing* He desires of you for 2018.
- Once you think you have **the one thing** God desires of you in 2018, you should:
  - 1) Ask God to give you the necessary grace to change your way of thinking that has created habits.
  - 2) Ask God to give you the necessary grace to persevere to create the new habits.
- We are on the 14<sup>th</sup> day of our twenty day congregational fast.
- I said that God wants to bless you abundantly!!!

  (20 Now to Him who is able to do exceedingly abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that works in us,) [Eph. 3:20]
- I said that while you are seeking God on the two questions, I think He wants me to give you <u>four</u> main areas <u>that</u>
   *prevent Him from blessing us like He wants to bless us.*
- Last week, I gave you one area with two examples in that main area #1: *An Unbridled tongue* (not controlled or restrained).
  - 1) Speaking against one another. (James 4:11-12)
  - 2) Listening to gossip. (Proverbs 18:8)

- 2) Zaccheus was greedy (covetous).
- 3) Judas Iscariot who betrayed Jesus was in some ways like Zaccheus.
- 4) Let's go to school on what happened to Zaccheus.
- Luke 19:1-10 (the story of Zaccheus)
  - 1) "The Zaccheus Principle" says that: When God changes your heart in an area, there will be a corresponding change in the way you think and act.
  - 2) **Luke 12:13-34** (15Then He said to them, "Beware, and be on your guard against every form of greed; for not *even* when one has an abundance does his life consist of his possessions.")
  - 3) **Matthew 6:24-34** (21for where your treasure is, there your heart will be also. 24No man can serve two masters: for either he will hate the one, and love the other; or else he will hold to the one, and despise the other. Ye cannot serve God and mammon.)
  - 4) **Proverbs 3:5-10** (5Trust in the LORD with all your heart and do not lean on your own understanding. 9Honor the LORD from your wealth and from the first of all your produce; 10So your barns will be filled with plenty and your vats will overflow with new wine.)
