Intro: Greeting from Seven Lakes, NC. I'm the site pastor there and also an elder there for many years, my wife of 30 years is Joanna Coxe she was the children's ministry director at both campus.

We came there 28 years ago, I would go so far as to say we looked pretty good on the outside, we were young, had good jobs... but on the inside we broken and at best living a nominal Christian life. That changed here in community!

We love the Church because Church is not a building it's people, "The People of God!"

That's how we believe God sees it, God has always desired a People for himself, a people he could reveal his glory to and people he could display his glory through.

God has always been about Community **Genesis 1:26**

26Then God said, "Let us make man in our image, after our likeness.

Genesis 2:18

Then the Lord God said, "It is not good that the man should be alone;

And God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply and fill the earth and subdue it,

Jesus himself lived in community – he had the 12 that he poured into as he fulfilled His mission here on earth.

After Jesus's death, burial and resurrection he gave his disciples two commands, Go into all the world, but before you go wait in Jerusalem for the promise of the Holy Spirit

I'm going read the story of the birth of the church and than we are going to pray - Two questions: Lord what are you saying about my place in this and what do you want me to do about it.

Acts 2 (NIV)

41 Those who accepted his message were baptized, and about three thousand were added to their number that day.

42 They devoted themselves to the apostles' teaching and to fellowship, to the breaking of bread and to prayer.

44 All the believers were together and had everything in common. "Common Purpose"

46 Every day they continued to meet together in the temple courts. They broke bread in their homes and ate together with glad and sincere hearts, 47 praising God and enjoying the favor of all the people. And the Lord added to their number daily those who were being saved.

46 They worshiped together regularly at the Temple each day, met in small groups in homes for Communion, and shared their meals with great joy and thankfulness, 47 praising God. The whole city was favorable to them, and each day God added to them all who were being saved.

10 The Son of Man came to find lost people and save them." Jacob's Story -Have you ever lost a child? Anybody that would have helped me through that search process I would have been grateful, I think the Lord is the same way

Luke 15 Jesus share's three stories about lost things and in all three we says he would leave what is found to go after what is lost!

Relationships must be a core value

1 Thessalonians 2:8 (NIV)

8so we cared for you. Because we loved you so much, we were delighted to share with you not only the gospel of God but our lives as well. The Church is Plan A, there is no plan B

Myths about small Groups

- It's a waste of time
- It's not what I want or what I need
- It's awkward

Truth about Small Groups

It's a place where you can make a difference

1 Corinthians 9:22 (LB)

Yes, whatever a person is like, I try to find common ground with him so that he will let me tell him about Christ and let Christ save him.

Share about the refrigerator – our current small Group Started a skip one account

It's a place where you can grow

Proverbs 27:17 (NIV)

"As iron sharpens iron, so one person sharpens another."

It's a place where everybody knows your name.

16 This is how we know what love is: Jesus Christ laid down his life for us. And we ought to lay down our lives for our brothers and sisters.

Share about the impact of Small Group on Joanna and me.

We "in group" can impact more people directly or indirectly for Christ than any other way including what we do on Sunday morning.
